## What is a Study Abroad programme?

- a study programme which allows a student to live in a foreign country and attend a foreign university
- 2 universities have an arrangement which allows them to exchange students
- part of a degree program done through educational activities outside the home country
- activities include classroom study, research, intern- or externships, volunteering, service learning etc.
- program grants credit for courses taken at the foreign institution



### Growing trend of US Study Abroad programmes

- 300,000 American students annually pursue study abroad for credit
- The top ten destinations for U.S. students studying abroad are: United Kingdom, Italy, Spain, France, China, Germany, Ireland, Costa Rica, Australia and Japan
- Motivation for study abroad: fast-changing world and increasingly globalized political and economic landscape
- Study abroad programmes offer:
- the experience of new, culturally and educationally diverse perspectives
- Iearning how to adapt to unexpected circumstances
- how to work with diverse peers, and
- communicate in other languages.

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### **US education: leaders in internationalisation**

- **The US HE system**: Over 4600 accredited HEIs in the USA with over 20.2 million enrolled students annually
- Leaders in intrernationalistation: 1,043,839 intl students in 2015./16.; 91.915 EU students; 527 Croatian students
- Increase of US Study Abroad program attendees in Croatia:

the number of US students on Study Abroad programs in Croatia increased for 6,1%, amounting to a total of 350 US students in Croatia in 2015./16





## **US Study Abroad Platform in Croatia**

- Key project activities:
  - capacity building seminar in Zagreb on strategies for developing institutional partnerships that promote internationalisation and student exchange collaboration between U.S and Croatian HEIs
  - an online platform containing guidelines and tools for intl collaboration and exchange


